

SUBJECT: NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS

A non-resident is one whose parents (or legal guardian) reside outside the school district. The Board of Education grants to the Superintendent of Schools the authority to admit non-resident students, provided that:

- a) The student can benefit from the instructional services and program available in the Port Jervis Schools;
- b) The student will not be a discipline problem which will add to the burden of the staff and threaten the health, safety, and welfare of the student body;
- c) The admission of the student will not increase class sizes beyond maximum acceptable limits;
- d) Parents must pay tuition costs approved annually by the Board of Education.

Future Residents

Children of non-resident families who have signed a contract to buy, rent, or build a residence in the school district may be enrolled without tuition for the semester in which they will become residents.

Former Resident

Children of families who have moved out of the school district during a semester may complete that semester in the Port Jervis Schools without tuition. Boys and girls who are seniors in the Port Jervis High School and who move from the City School District of the City of Port Jervis (CSD) to another district with which no contractual tuition agreement presently exists shall be permitted, if they so desire, to finish their senior year in Port Jervis with no tuition charged, subject to the following conditions:

- a) The student shall be doing satisfactory work academically;
- b) The student shall present no behavior problem;
- c) The parents shall be responsible for providing transportation.

Visiting Students – Foreign

Students may be admitted (for not more than one year) without tuition when:

- a) They are part of a regularly operated foreign exchange student program;
- b) They bring with them qualities the Board feels may be beneficial to the school system.

Foster Children

Children of non-resident families placed in foster homes within the district may attend district schools. The district of their family residence will be billed for tuition.

Special Request of Other School Districts

Children of non-resident families may be admitted upon request of other school districts in special cases on a tuition basis.
