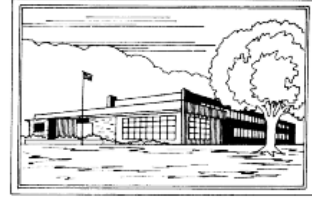

Dear Parent, Guardian, and School Staff:

New York Education Law, Section 409-H, effective July 1, 2001, requires all public and nonpublic elementary and secondary schools to provide written notification to all parents/guardians, faculty and staff regarding the potential use of pesticides periodically throughout the school year.

The Port Jervis City School District is required to maintain a list of persons ( parents/guardians, faculty and staff) who wish to receive 48-hour prior written notification of certain pesticide applications, to include the location applied, date of application, product name, and EPA number.

The written request forms are available at the main office of each school or at the Board of Education Building, 9 Thompson Street in Port Jervis. You can also request a form by mail, by writing to Port Jervis City School District, Buildings & Grounds Department, PO Box 1104, Port Jervis, NY, 12771, Attention Don Preiss. **RETURN THE COMPLETED FORM TO THE BUILDINGS & GROUNDS OFFICE, ATTENTION DON PREISS.**
