Current "Issues"

- Imbalance between ASK & HBE (total population, class size)
- Less than desirable structure of grades & locations
 - Elementary / High School combined, not ideal alignment
 - Middle School only 7 − 8, preference would be 6 − 8
- Aging Middle School infrastructure (built in 1922)
- Middle School room sizes do not meet current standards
- District Administration Offices Building is in poor condition
- Need to address items identified in 2015 BCS





Problems:

- Imbalance between ASK & HBE (total population, class size)
- Less than desirable structure of grades & locations

Possible Solutions:

- Districtwide grade / building re-alignment
 - "Even out" ES populations between ASK & HBE
 - 6th Grade to MS; Same class size at both Elem Schools
 - Create two K 5 Elementary Schools
 - Create one 6 8 Middle School
 - High school structure remains the same (9 12)





New Grade / Building Alignment:

- Create new grade / building alignment as follows:
 - HBE (K 5) Elementary (remains as is but K-5 not K-6)
 - Current Middle School becomes new K 5 Elementary
 - Convert Route 209 complex:
 - 6 − 8 Middle School (renovate current ASK)
 - 9 12 High School (remains as is)
 - District Administration moves into wing of current ASK (new MS)





Problems:

- Aging Middle School infrastructure
- Middle School room sizes do not meet current standards

Possible Solutions:

- Completely renovate existing Middle School
- To address small room sizes and increased K 5 population
 - Create new addition housing gym, lockers, cafeteria, kitchen, building administration with new secure entry
 - Renovate existing gym & auditorium into new classrooms
 - Renovate entire remaining building & MEP systems to create a thoroughly modern Elementary school





Problems:

- District Administration Offices Building is in poor condition
- Need to address items identified in 2015 BCS

Possible Solutions:

- Move District Admin to wing of current ASK
 - Gets District Admin "back on campus"
- Over \$19m of infrastructure improvements identified in 2015
 BCS

Package all identified issues into a New Capital Project and take advantage of your Building Aid – Goal: No new taxes!

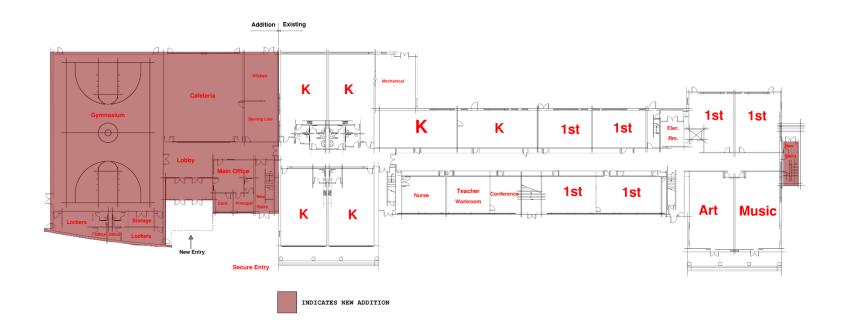

Proposed First Floor Plan

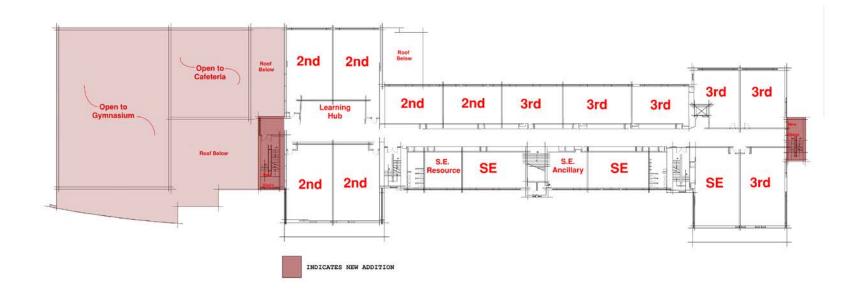

Proposed Second Floor Plan

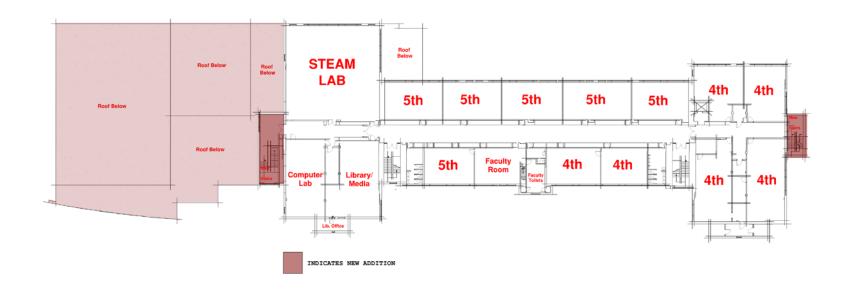

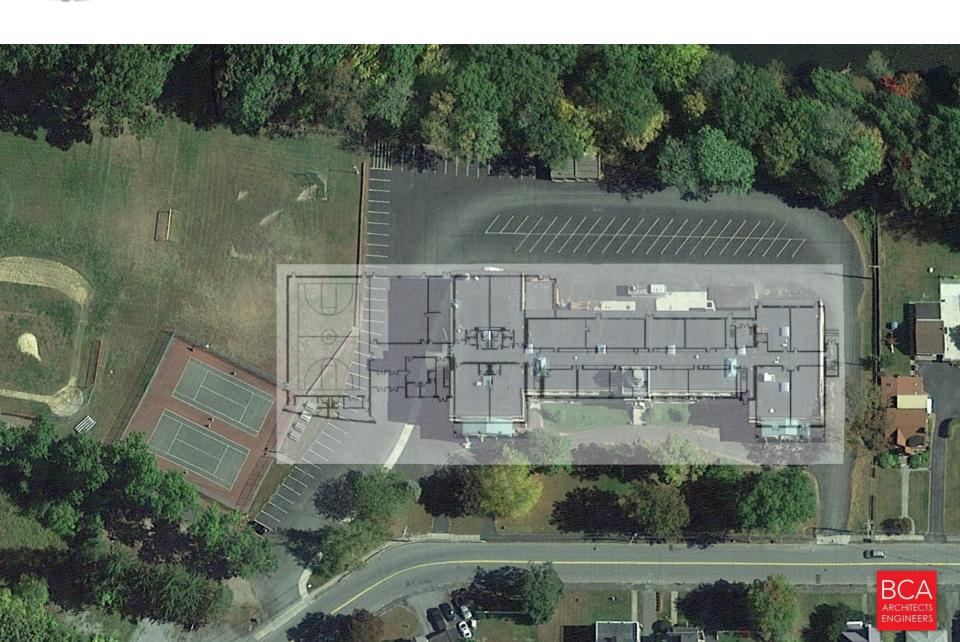

Proposed First Floor Plan



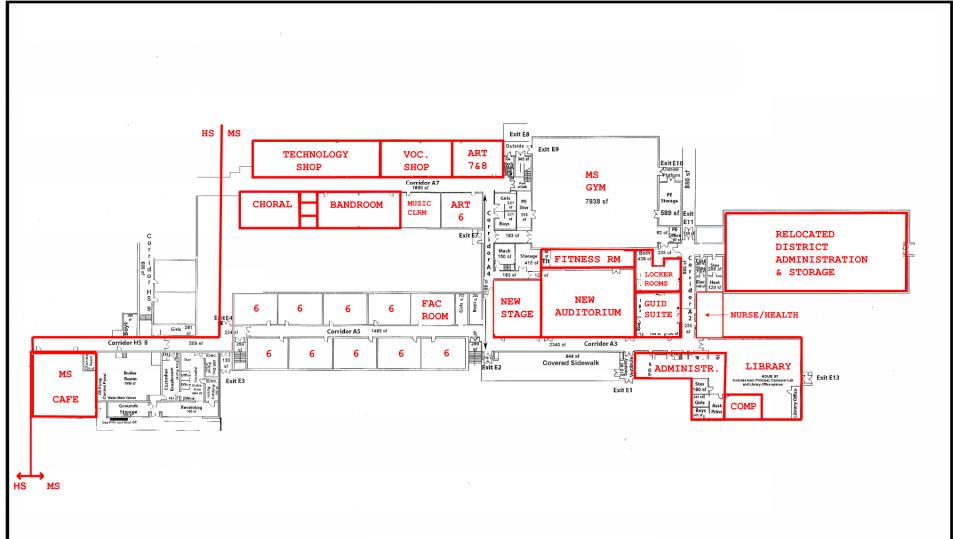
HAMILTON BICENTENNIAL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL FIRST FLOOR PLAN

FIRST FLOOR PLAN

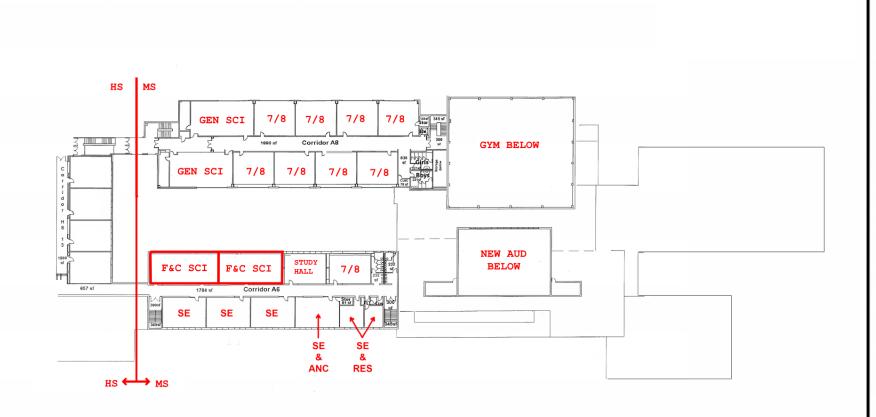

SECOND FLOOR PLAN

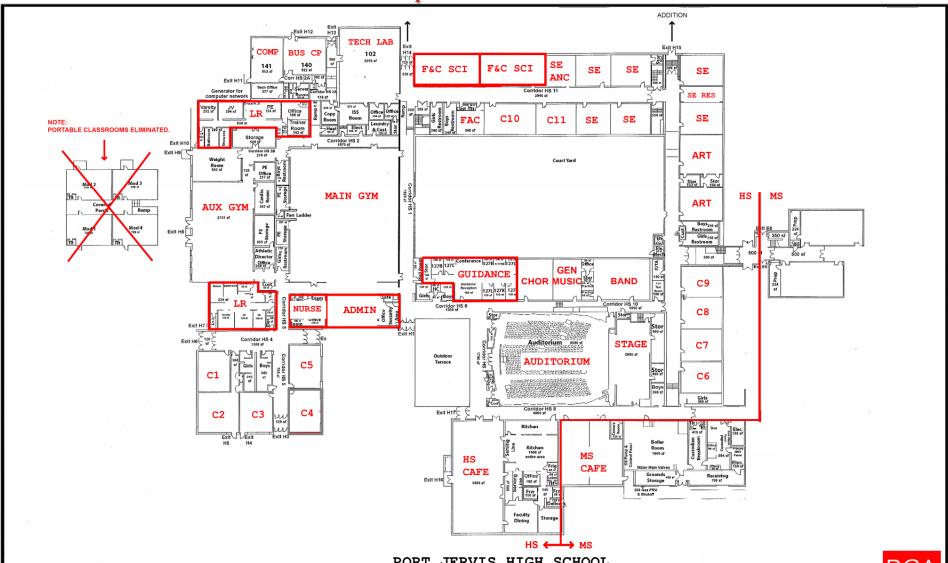

Proposed First Floor Plan



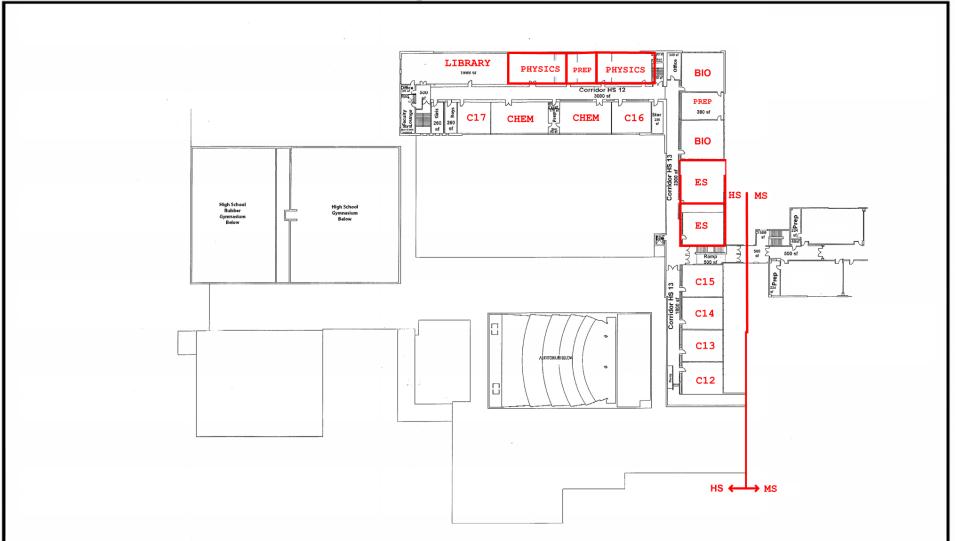
PORT JERVIS HIGH SCHOOL FIRST FLOOR PLAN

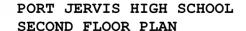

PORT JERVIS HIGH SCHOOL/MIDDLE SCHOOL - ATHLETIC FIELD CONCEPT



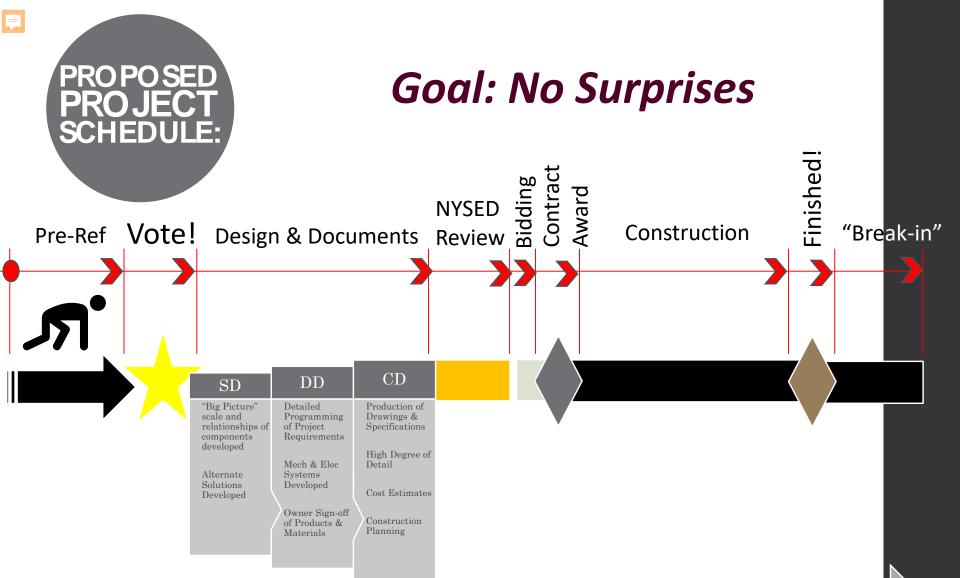


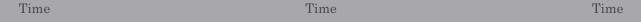
Estimate of Probable Cost

Proposed Costs – All In

Facility	<u>Estimate</u>
High School	\$ 3,574,688
Middle School & District Offices (former ASK)	\$ 7,166,550
Main Street Elementary (former MS)	\$25,257,284
HB Elementary	\$ 1,292,025
Maintenance Building	\$ 35,248
Subtotal:	\$37,325,795
Design Contingency & Inflation	\$ 3,732,578
Construction Contingency @ 10%	\$ 4,105,837
Incidental & Financing Costs	\$ 9,730,790
Total Estimated Project Costs:	\$54,895,000

Timeline for Success

Pre-Ref Phase:

- Project Scoping: Complete by 12/10/19
- **SEQRA Approval**: Complete by 01/21/20 (Type I Action)
- BOE Resolution for Capital Project: 01/21/20
- Notice of Proposition Posted: No later than 01/27/20
- Public Referendum: Assumes March 11, 2020

Design Phase (could be phased):

- March Nov 2020: Design Phase / SED Submission
- Dec 2020 March 2021: SED Review Period
