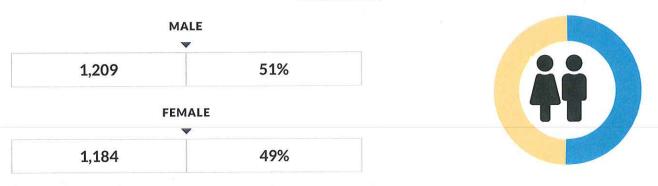

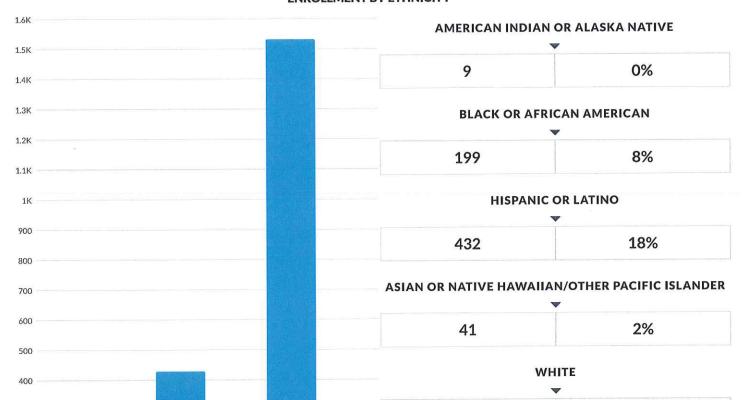

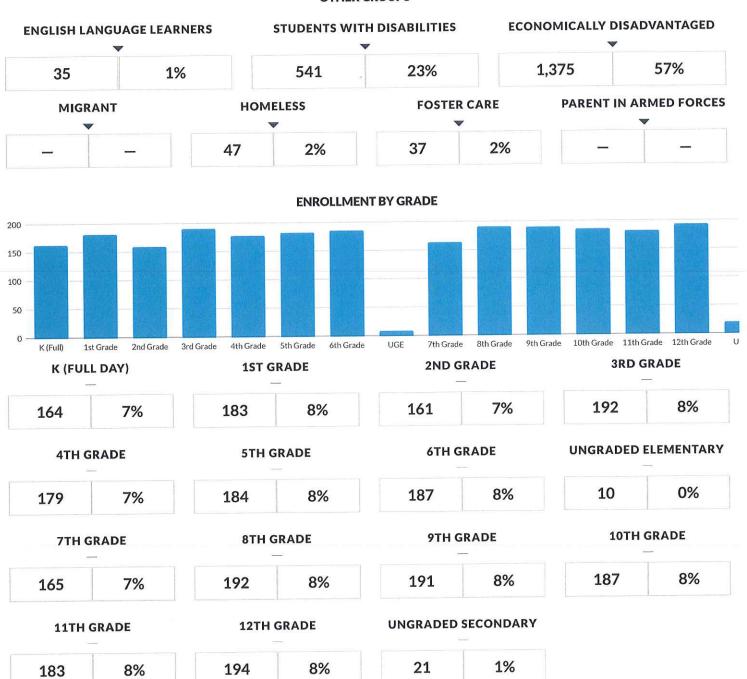
ENROLLMENTI

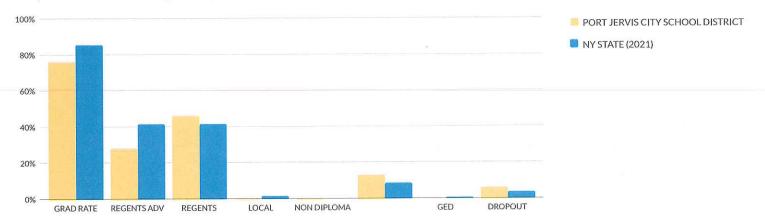

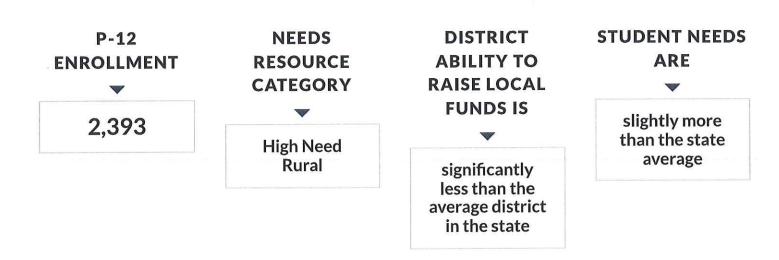
