As the media coverage regarding the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) has been extensive, the central purpose of this communication is to share with our learning community the protocols that are followed in our schools to ensure that our learning spaces are as clean as possible. Our facilities team works diligently each day to effectively follow these protocols that exceed the recommendations for minimizing the spread of bacterial and viral infections, inclusive of COVID-19 and Influenza.

Specific to our cleaning and disinfecting routine:

- All tabletops, desktops, door handles, light switches, restroom surfaces, and other surfaces in common areas are cleaned and disinfected daily.
- A Clorox 360 electrostatic machine is used in each classroom at least one time per week.
- Every classroom has disinfecting wipes at their disposal for use during the school day.

The health and wellness of our students, faculty, staff, and their families are of the highest regard. Our facilities team has followed the above protocols throughout the winter months and will continue to do so.
