For narratives, remember to:

- begin with a lead that introduces the characters and setting,
- stretch out your story and add details about actions, feelings, and thoughts
- Use dialogue
- Use transition words
- Include a conclusion

Informational topics can be based on something you research using Reading A-Z or Brainpop resources.
