- 70% of jobs will soon require some level of postsecondary education/training



Cost Breakdown

Assuming 22 students in a class

College	Cost Comparisons Per Course		
SUNY Albany (new partner)	\$190/\$95 per student= \$2,990 <i>(3 or 4 credits)</i>		
SUNY ESF (expanded offerings)	\$200/\$75 per student= \$3,275 (3 credits)		
SUNY Orange (expanded offerings)	\$39/ credit= \$2574 (3 credits), \$3,432 (4 credits)		
Mount Saint Mary (new partner)	\$2,800 (3 credits), \$3,700 (4 credits)		
Syracuse/SUPA (no longer partnered)	\$230/\$115 per credit= \$12,075 (3 credits), \$16,010 (4 credits)		

Potential Cost Savings for Students

School	30 credits (Tuition and Fees)*

SUNY Albany	\$10,468		
Mount Saint Mary College	\$18,970		
Marist College	\$44,280
